The company launched its DeepSea G2 Stereo Vision System in late 2006. The DeepSea G2 is a small, multi-purpose, embedded stereo camera that can be deployed in mobile platforms such as commercial and defense robots, automobiles, or networked together into person-tracking security systems. Tyzx has been providing its G2 stereo vision systems to key partners, such as NASA, Unisys Corporation and Takata Group, to further develop and test the technology.
